We are extremely grateful to our Community Partners for the support they provide to SunBridge. We could not provide the nurturing environment for our students without their continuing support.


Thanks go, as always, to our wonderful staff for all of their hard work and to our sponsor, OCCS, for their continued support.

Our Mission:

SunBridge Schools commits to offering children in under-served areas the educational opportunities they need to reach their full potential by preparing them to graduate from high school. We will do this by helping them develop the necessary academic and social tools, along with a strong sense of values and character, within an atmosphere of love and respect. SunBridge Schools fully supports the whole child in his/her pursuit of excellence in the four foundational domains of development: cognitive, social, emotional, and physical.



Our Students and Families:

- 91% of our enrolled students are African American, 5% are Caucasian, 3% are Multi-Ethnic, and 1% Other.
- 99% of our students live at least 1 mile from SunBridge Schools.
- 100% of our families report income at or below the federal poverty level, based on the federal free/reduced lunch eligibility guidelines.
- 16% of our students are on an Individualized Education Plan for Special Education Services (IEP).




